AN ORDINANCE

INSTALLATION OF CULVERTS IN PRIVATE DRIVES

The Town Board of the Town of Highland, County of Douglas, State of Wisconsin does ordain as follows:

Section1. All parties constructing or using new drives off of all Town roads located within the Town of Highland are required to install a metal culvert of at least fifteen (15) inches in diameter at the proper level for proper drainage in the ditch line unless otherwise authorized by the Town Board.

Section 2. Penalty. Any person violating this ordinance shall not be granted any Town building permits and may be subject to a penalty of \$25.00 a day until they are in compliance.

Effective Date: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after one (1) week from the date of passage and posting of this ordinance and proof of such posting is filed in the Town records by the Town Clerk.
